Student musicians from three age categories are eligible to participate. This year's competition will focus on woodwinds, brass, percussion, and piano. One student from each age group will be invited to perform his/her solo work in concert at the Kahilu Theatre in Waimea, HI as a part of the Kamuela Philharmonic Orchestra's "En Pointe Brilliance" concert performance on January 27, 2019. There will be scholarship prizes for the winners as well.

- Entrants must audition with a composition appropriate for performance with orchestral accompaniment which does not exceed 15 minutes in length.
- Entrants must provide their own accompanist for the audition.
- Entrants must provide three (3) copies of their music being performed for the judges.

Teachers, please help your students to confirm that the piece they choose is appropriate for this occasion, and that orchestral accompaniment parts are available. *Any pieces that are not on the recommended repertoire list, must be approved by the Artistic Director of the Philharmonic before the application deadline.*

Application materials must be received by:

September 1, 2018
